Council Chamber May 22, 1850

The Council met upon a call of the President
Present - A full Council.

The President announced the object of the meeting; when Mr. Louden presented the following preamble and resolutions for adoption:

Whereas, Intelligence has been received that his excellency Gov. Wood of the State of Ohio will pay a visit to the City of Indianapolis: therefore

Be it resolved, That the City Council of the City of Indianapolis hereby tender to Gov. Wood, the hospitality of the City during his stay among us, and that we will attend in a body, with the Mayor and receive the Governor on his arrival.

Resolved farther, That Messrs. Louden, Woodward & Edwards be appointed a committee to make the necessary arrangements to carry into effect the foregoing resolution.

Which was read and anaminously adopted.

Mr Edwards offered for adoption the following resolution:

Resolved, That the City Engineer report to the Council whether it is advisable & practicable to change the course of the water on each side of Washington Street from Illinois to the canal, and what has, if any, been done under an order of this Council directing a Change in the grade of the gutters on said Washington Street between the points aforesaid."
