The following petition was read to wit: "The undersigned, holders and Lessees of Property on the North side of Washington Street between Meridian and Illinois Streets, respectfully Petition the Honorable Common Council of Indianapolis to pass an Ordinance requiring the holders of Property and Lessees or Agents of Property holders to Grade, Curb, and Pave the side walks between Meridian and Illinois Streets Twenty ft. in front of their property, under

the supervision the town Engineer etc and cause the same to be done by the 1st day of November next.
