Mr. Seibert, presented a relinquishment and release by the owners of the pump in front of Union row on Washington Street, (Commonly called Davis pump), to the Common Council And also a petition asking the Common Council to receive said pump and cause it to be repaired & kept in repair as a public pump and well:

On Motion of Mr. Seibert

Resolved that the Common Council accede to the proposition to take keep and repair said pump in front of Union Row Washington Street and that a committee be appointed to contract with some person or persons for the repair of said pump and well. Messrs Seibert & Norwood were appointed said committee.

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Mr. Sullivan from the committee appointed to examine the accounts of the Collector reported "That the Collector has vouchers for payment in to the Treasury of the sum of \$3944.50 cts. of the Revenue of 1839 - being \$139.53⁴/₄ cts less than the whole assessment of 1839 - That said Collector has accounted for the sum of \$38:48¹/₂ cts of the outstanding Revenue of 1838 And for an old Pump Stalk \$1:75 cts. Making in all (not otherwise settled) the sum of \$3984:73¹/₂" which reporte was concurred in.

The Treasurer made his annual report to the Council pursuant to an order heretofore made.

Ordered that the Secretary make a copy of the Treasurers Annual Report and have the same published in the Indiana Journal and Indiana Democrat.

Mr. Norwood from the Committee appointed to view Meredian Street where Pogues run crosses the same, made a report which was laid on the table.

Resolved That James Vanblaricum be allowed the sum of \$25. for extra services as Marshal & Market Master for the past year. (Issd. 31 March 40)

Council met pursuant to adjournment, Present N.B. Palmer President, J. Lockerbie, W Sullivan J.E. McCluer P.W. Seibert and G. Norwood Councilmen.

Mr. Seibert from the Committee on that subject reported that Mr. $D_e vid Creviston Contractor on wells had performed his con$ tract and the whole amount of work done was 2104:00% upon whichsd. David Creviston has received the sum of 266:20% leaving abalance due said Creviston of 468:07% of which the third being\$34:92 of the contract has to be retained as Security that thework will stand good for one year, And also that there is nowdue and payable to said Creviston the sum of 253:15% which saidCreviston is now entitled to receive.

Ordered therefore that the Secretary issue orders to Matthew Little and Micholas McCarty for a pro rata share of said \$33:15 pursuant to orders given by said Creviston to said Little & McCarty viz; to Matther Little said Creviston gave an order for fifty collars and to Micholas McCarty he gave an order for nineteen dollars & five cents; which orders were accepted by the Council and to be paid by said Council in proportion to indebtedness of the Council to said Creviston.

Ordered further that the above sum of \$34:92 shall also be paid on the above orders of Little & McCarty in pro rato proportion as aforesaid so soon as said Creviston shall give Security >uuuuu

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
