Council met, present a full Council -

Henry Bradley the assessor returned his list of assessments and valuations which was received.

The Treasurer made reports for the months of May and June which received and adopted.

On Motion of J. Cox

Resolved That the Committee on Engines be authorized to draw from the Treasury what monies may be required for the transportation of the Engine purchased by J.H. Wright

Allowed Fultz & Co. \$100. on contract for work on Massachusetts Avenue & Delaware Street
(Issd by P.W.S.)

On Motion of Mr Cox

Resolved That a committee be appointed to present an ordinance regulating the side walks on the streets excepting Washington Street Messrs Seibert Loudon & Little were appointed said committee.

Allowed the Supervisor \$100 for work done in ward no. 1.
(Issd by P.W.S.)

Allowed L. Munsel, Surveyor \$19 as per account filed
(Issd by P.W.S.)

Allowed the Supervisor \$10 for work done near Pogue's run and Kentucky Avenue.

(Issd July 7 1840)

A Petition was presented by Douglass ORiley and others citizens of the first ward which was laid on the table.

H.P. Todd presented an account which was referred to a committee consisting of Messrs Norwood & Goldsberry

N. Cox presented an account which was referred to a committee consisting of Messrs Seibert & Cox

And the Council adjourned to meet on the 8th June 1840
