Indianapolis March 29th 1845.

Council met pursuant to adjournment: All the members Present except Mr. Nowland.

The Committee appointed to examine the Delinquent list Returned by the Collector and other matters contained in the Report of said Collector made at the last meeting of the Council, made the following Report which was adopted, to wit:

"The Committee to whom was assigned the duty of examing and Comparing the Delinquent List Returned by Henry Ohr Collector of the Revenue of the town of Indianapolis for the year A.D. 1844; also the amount of Illegal Assessments made by the Lister for 1844, as returned by said Collector; and also to accertain the amt. of Commission due said Collector on monies paid into the Treasury -- beg leave to make the following report.

On Motion of Rooker then offered the following Resolution - viz

Resolved That the Treasurer be authorized to settle with T. M. Weaver Supervisor of the town of Indianapolis for the year 1843 and to give him a clear receipt and release of all demands which the Common Council of the town of Indianapolis now have against him as such Supervisor, And that the Secretary be Ordered to issue an Order to said Weaver for \$6.13 on the Treasury as so much money due said Supervisor on Settlement -- Which Resolution was not adopted.

On Motion of Mr. Griffith it was Resolved That, an amount be passed to the Credit of T. M. Weaver, Supervisor, sufficient to balance the account between him said Supervisor and the Common Council of the town of Indianapolis.

The President laid before the Council the report of his Proceedings as President of Common Council since July 8th 1844, the amount of fines assessed, and moneys Collected, and also his acct. for fees for the same period which was read and received.
