Common Council of the town of Indianapolis now have against him as
such Supervisor, And that the Secretary be Ordered to issue an Order
to said Neaver for \$6.13 on the Treasury as so much money due said
Supervisor on Settlement -- Which Resolution was not adopted.

On Motion of Mr. Griffith it was Resolved That, an amount be passed to the Credit of T. M. Weaver, Supervisor, sufficient to balance the account between him said Supervisor and the Common Council of the town of Indianapolis.

The President laid before the Council the report of his Proceedings as President of Common Council since July 8th 1844, the amount of fines assessed, and moneys Collected, and also his acct. for fees for the same period which was read and received.
