ABSTRACT

Concentrations of purified suspensions of the virus of vaccinia. C. A. BEHRENS and G. H. ECHELBARGER, Purdue University.—Suspensions of the virus of vaccinia, from which approximately 85% of the foreign matter was removed by precipitating it at its isolectric-point, were concentrated by means of vacuum distillation. Dilutions of such preparations, when injected into rabbits, gave reactions at comparable dilutions of suspensions of the original calf smallpox lymph.
