Serge Segay: Mailart, Stampart, from Russia appeared at the Stamp Art Gallery, San Francisco, the month of August.

Italian mail art by Bruno Pollacci appeared during November at the Stamp Art Gallery, 466 8th St., San Francisco, and in December Marcello Diotallevi's mail art and stamp art will appear.

In the Spirit of Fluxus, the traveling show generated by the Walker Art Gallery in Minneapolis, has now finished its run at the Santa Barbara Museum of Art--and will leave for Barcelona. Artist Elena Siff, co-curator of a show of Mail Art in connection with the exhibition, tells us that work was removed from the show because it was considered offensive. Also, the museum's board was asked to preview Yoko Ono's film, "The Fly, before it screened to the public on 9 September. In fact, "someone in the community took photos of some of the pieces in ...the show and presented them to the museum with a complaint. No one ever said anything to me, but pieces are missing and there are spaces on the wall where things had been. This is bizarre treatment, and I would like to know whose decision this was," said Siff. As a result, the room was closed because of "plumbing problems" on one day.

Siff, who visited the exhibition after it reopened, said that among the pieces that were missing were a phallic-like metal sculpture and an elephant mask with a trunk and ears made of condoms stuffed with tissue paper. She wrote a letter to acting museum director Barbara Luton accusing the museum of censorship, and the "missing" sculpture later reappeared in the show. Ironically enough, "Condom Man", the censored artwork discussed in the article by Joan Crowder, mentioned above, was a collaborative effort by X, Ray Johnson, and M.B. Corbett. This exhibition contained 2,000 pieces of mail art placed in the "Conference Room" with no sign to indicate to viewers of the Fluxus Show where the Mail Art Show was to be seen.

Networks Discussions: Reports on the DNC 92 by Angela & Peter Netmail was published in Jakarta, Indonesia in 1993 by Blacky's Image Lounge. According to the authors, these are the only documents on the theory production of the network during the DNCs. Thanks to Byron Black IN Jakarta, this book has been published with selections from Mayumi and Shozo, Ignazio Corsaro & Vittore Baroni and Anna Boschi from Italy; Anna Banana and Michael Duquette from Canada; Bern Porter, Carlo Pittore, Bill Gaglione and Carol Stetser from the US; Dobrica Kamperelic & Svetlana Mimica from ex-Yugoslavia; Sofia Martinou from Greece; Jose Oliveira from Portugal; Julia & Gyorgy Galantai from Hungary, and many others.

An article on Patriotic Postcards appeared in the July 1994 issue of Smithsonian.

31 fake stamps were intentionally put through the Canadian Post, mailed by Ottawa-based Frank magazine, including one depicting a black man severely beaten by police and another of pop singer Mitsou. The series of 13 stamps had Quebec printed in large letters on theme as well as a price of 43F, presumably the province's postseparation currency. This is the second time the magazine has pulled the stunt on Canada Post.

Stamp Art Gallery in San Francisco had an exhibition of handcarved art stamps by Stephen Kaplin, 17 September - 15 October 1994.

Genesis P-Orridge was featured in an exhibition at the Rita Dean Gallery, San Diego, CA, 7 - 31 January, in which there were many books of mail att included in this all-encompassing exhibition of the work of this performance, musical, and mail att artist from the United Kingdom.

Engenio Dittborn showed his "Airmail Paintings" at the Center for the Fine Arts, Miami, FL, 22 January - 3 March 1994. The found texts and images from Dittborn's own archive are mailed in envelopes to any venue that shows his work.
