In 1916, according to postal historian Meg Ausman, a merchant named W. H. Coltharp mailed an entire bank-in small packages-via parcel post from Salt Lake City to Vernal, Utah. Apparently, thre was no road between the two cities, so Coltharp figured he could save on transportation costs by having mail carriers haul the building's 80,000 bricks over the 427-mile route.

When Postmaster General Albert Burleson later heard about the stunt, he issued a decree outlawing such mailings, saying "It is not the intent of the United States Postal Service that buildings should be shipped through the mail."

REVIEWS

I'm Still in Love with You by Steven Hull is the result of a mail art event, in which Hull asked artists and writer to respond to the 1972 album by Al Green and the exhibition was held at the Twentieth Century Women's Club and Ellen Birrell's Studio in Eagle Rock, California from February -March 1998. There were 46 visual artists and 29 writers who participated in the show. The catalog is in the form of a long playing record jacket printed in glossy color stock and contains an LP with songs by Jim Shaw, Simon Leung and Charles Gaines plus other Al Green songs on a CD. Included is a book in which there are entries of all the participants plus an essay by Steven Hull. Quite an accomplished documentation for an exhibition that certainly has more in its documentation both with the CD, LP and book than most mail art exhibitions. A delicious tribute.

Art in The City, a survey of the Mail Art Mekka Minden in September 1999 was accompanied by fancy dragon faxes in a storefront window, artistamps and mail delivered in a public yellow phonebooth, peace wishes swinging from the trees The book is full of black and white and full color reproductions of all the entries from more than 100 participants.
