Against U.S. Intervention in Central America

Thousands of artists, writers, poets, musicians, journalists and teachers in El Salvador and other Central American countries have been murdered and tortured by U.S.-backed forces there since 1980. Today the U.S. is on the brink of direct intervention in El Salvador, and has committed millions of dollars to continue a "secret" war in Nicaragua.

ARTIST CALL is a solidarity group organizing exhibitions, performances and publicity campaigns throughout the U.S. to show support for the people and culture of Central America. Galleries and artists have donated space and artworks for a multi-cultural exhibit to open January 21, 1984 at the United Nations, the eve of the International Day of Solidarity with El Salvador. Similar exhibits of North and Central American artists' work are planned in Washington, D.C., Chicago, Albuquerque and Los Angeles where ARTIST CALL branches exist.
