Mike Duquette apologizes for the delay of Commonpress 42, because he could not use the material until the show about "Postal Regulations Mail Art Show" closed at Factory 77, a non-profit artist-run alternative gallery in Toronto. In addition, the postal strike in Canada during the summer for six weeks also delayed the project, since Duquette works for the Post Office and was on the picket line for six weeks! Now he assures his friends that Commonpress 42 will be off the presses soon.

■ URGENT! Bruno Talpo, the Italian Artists' Union and Edgardo Vigo, father of Palomo, urge you all to send Special Delivery Letters, Telegrams of Appeal directly to Presidente Eduardo Viola, Casa Rosada, Buenos Aires, Argentina for the liberation of Palomo-Abel Luis Vigo and to denounce the situation of arresting people and making them disappear in that country!

Since 1976, the detention of 4,000 officially acknowledged prisoners, the widespread use of sophisticated means of torture, and the disappearance after arrest of thousands of Argentines, refugees and foreign nationals living in Argentina are a chilling phenomenon in that country. Help Find Palomo!
