PROCEEDINGS OF JOINT CONVENTION.

THIRD SESSION—APRIL 3, 1890.

His Honor, the Mayor, stated that the Joint Convention was called for the purpose of electing members of a Board of Public Improvements, created by General Ordinance No. 19, 1890, ordained and established March 24th, 1890.

The resignation of the members of the Board of Public Improvements, elected in Joint Convention held January 10th, 1890, was presented and accepted.

Councilman Hicklin placed in nomination Councilmen Burns, Gauss and Cooper.

There being no further nominations, the Secretary was instructed to cast the unanimous vote of the Joint Convention for Councilmen Burns, Gauss and Cooper.

Whereupon the President declared them duly elected members of the Board of Public Improvements for the term ending December 31st, 1890, or until their successors shall have been elected.

On motion, the Joint Convention adjourned, subject to the call of the President.
