General Ordinance No. 72-1912: An ordinance regulating all matters concerning, affecting or pertaining to the construction, alteration, repairs or additions to, remodeling, removal, ownership, use or occupation of all buildings, parts of buildings, and structures of every nature whatsoever, in the City of Indianapolis, Indiana; also all improvements, machinery, equipment, furniture, fixtures, signs, electric wiring, appliances and appurtenances used in connection with such buildings, parts of buildings, or structures, or installed therein or thereon, and providing for the closing, the condemning and the stopping of the use thereof the razing and wrecking of the same, and the removal of the wreckage; creating the Office of the Commissioner of Buildings, with a chief clerk, stenographer, chief inspectors, and assistant inspectors, defining their duties, and authority, fixing their compensation, requiring them to give bond, take an oath of office, and be selected by competitive examination before a Board of Examiners, providing for the ap-pointment of such a board, the selection of their time and place of meeting, fixing their compensation, providing the kind of an examination to be given, and how the same shall be conducted; providing for arbitration before bringing suit against the City; fixing fire limits in said City; regulating the construction, maintenance, use and removal of signs, sign boards and bill boards in said City.
