CHAMBER OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDIANAPOLIS,
MONDAY, NOVEMBER 2D, 1868, 7 O'CLOCK, P. M.

The Common Council met in regular session.

Present—His Honor, the Mayor, Daniel Macauley, in the chair, and the following members:

Councilmen Brown, Coburn, Cottrell, Davis, Foster, Geisel, Goddard, Jameson, Kappes, MacArthur, Schmidt, Seidensticker, Stanton and Woodburn—14.

Absent-Councilmen Burgess, Colley, Henschen and Loomis-4.

The proceedings of the Common Council held October 29th, 1868, were read and approved.

On motion by Mr. Cottrell, the bids for public works were referred to the Board of Public Improvements without reading.

Mr. Seidensticker offered the following motion:

That the ordinance for repairing Virginia Avenue, and the ordinance amending the Charter of the Street Railroad Company, be referred to the City Attorney, with instructions to report whether the city or the Street Railroad Company is liable for the cost of raising the track.

Which was adopted.

Dr. Jameson introduced general ordinance No. 164-1868, entitled:

An Ordinance extending the time for the construction of the Water Works.

Which was read the first time, and referred to the City Attorney.

On motion, the Council adjourned.
