Mr. President:

I move that Section 1, Line 4, of Police Special Service District Fiscal Ordinance No. 8, 1974, be amended, to read — provide for the purchase of a helicopter engine and four helmets and for the removal of third floor office to install a Communication System.

Section 2, Lines 1 and 2, be amended, to read as follows: Insert the words and figures Thirty-seven thousand nine hundred eighty dollars and eighty cents.

Section 3, should be amended under Line 4, and 5 to read \$37,980.80.

Section 4, should be amended to read -21 Services Contractual \$30,000.00 and 24 Current Charges \$7,980.80 for Total Reductions of \$37,980.00.
