

SPECIAL MEETING

Monday, January 6, 1975

A Special Meeting of the Police Special Service District Council of the City of Indianapolis met in Room Number 422, of the City-County Building at 7:20 p.m., Monday, January 6, 1975.

OFFICIAL COMMUNICATIONS

President Kimbell called for the reading of Official Communications. The Clerk read the following:

Ladies and Gentlemen:

I have this day approved with my signature and delivered to the Clerk of the Police Special Service District Council, Mrs. Jean A. Wyttenbach, the following Police Special Service District Ordinance.

FISCAL ORDINANCE NO. 9, 1974, approving temporary tax anticipation borrowing and authorizing temporary loans for the use of the Consolidated City Police Force Account and the Police Pension Fund during the period January 1, 1975 to June 27, 1975, in anticipation of current taxes levied in the year 1974, and collectible in the year 1975, authorizing the issuance of tax anticipation time warrants to evidence such loans; pledging and appropriating the taxes to be received in said Account and Fund to the payment of said tax anticipation time warrants including the interest thereon; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall take effect.

INTRODUCTION OF PROPOSALS

Police Special Service District Fiscal Ordinance No. 1, 1975. Introduced by Councilman Kimbell. The Clerk read the Proposal entitled: "Police Special Service District Fiscal Ordinance No. 1, 1975;" A Fiscal Ordinance amending the Police Force Budget for 1975 (Police Special Service District Fiscal Ordinance No. 7, 1974) and appropriating the additional sum of One hundred thirty-six thousand eight hundred twenty-eight dollars (\$136,828.00) in the Police Service District Fund for certain purposes of the Indianapolis Police Force for purposes of utilizing a comprehensive employment training act grant and reducing the unappropriated and unencumbered balance of the Police Service District Fund, and the Chairman referred it to the Committee of the Whole to be held for Public Hearing at a Special Meeting on Monday, January 20, 1975.

There being no further business, a motion was duly made by Councilman Hasbrook, seconded by Councilman Gorham that the meeting adjourn at 7:29 p.m.
