The Board of Public Works and Sanitation respectfully request that you cause to be prepared an ordinance appropriating the sum of \$3500.00 from the unexpended and unappropriated balance of the general fund of 1934, into City Civil Engineer No. 42, sewer materials, and submit the same to the Common Council at their next meeting, with the recommendation of the Board of Public Works and Sanitation that the same be passed.

This appropriation is greatly needed to buy sewer materials in conjunction with a W. P. A. project, providing for the cleaning and repairing of the city sewer system; and if this money is not made available we cannot proceed with this project.

## INTRODUCTION OF APPROPRIATION ORDINANCES

### APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 27, 1935

AN ORDINANCE appropriating the sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00) from the estimated unappropriated and unexpended balance of the General Fund for the year 1934, to the Department of Public Works, Civil Engineer, Fund No.

42—Sewer Materials, and fixing a time when the same shall take effect.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF INDIANAPOLIS, INDIANA:

Section 1. That there be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the estimated unappropriated and unexpended balance of the General Fund for the year 1934 the sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00) and said sum appropriated and transferred to the Department of Public Works, Civil Engineer, Fund No. 42—Sewer Materials.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval by the Mayor and publication as by law required.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.


On motion of Mr. Wallace, seconded by Mr. Carr, the Common Council adjourned at 4:30 p. m.
