#### REGULAR MEETING

Monday, January 2, 1939 7:30 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by John M. Layton, Clerk of the Council. The Deputy Clerk called the roll.

Present: Ollie A. Bach, Harmon A. Campbell, Albert O. Deluse, Walter E. Hemphill, Ralph F. Moore, F. B. Ransom, Ernest C. Ropkey, Guy O. Ross, Joseph G. Wood.

Mr. Layton announced that the first order of business would be the election of officers for the year 1939, and asked for nominations for the office of president of the Council.

Ollie Bach nominated Joseph G. Wood and the nomination was seconded by F. B. Ransom. Mr. Deluse made a motion that nominations be closed, which motion was seconded by Ollie Bach. Mr. Joseph G. Wood was elected President of the Council by the unanimous vote of the Council.

On invitation of the Clerk, Mr. Wood took the chair.

Mr. Wood, after a brief address accepting the office of President, called for the next order of business, same being election of Vice-President of the Council.

Mr. Deluse made a motion to nominate Guy O. Ross. The motion was seconded by Ralph Moore. Mr. Ransom made a motion that the nominations be closed. The motion was seconded by Mr. Bach. Mr. Guy O. Ross was duly elected Vice-President of the Council by the unanimous vote of the Council.

Mr. Wood asked for nominations for a member of the Council to serve on the City Plan Commission for the year 1939. Mr. Guy Ross placed the name of Albert O. Deluse in nomination. The nomination was seconded by Mr. Bach. Mr. Bach made a motion that the nominations be closed and that Mr. Deluse be elected by acclamation. The motion was seconded by Harmon A. Campbell and Mr. Deluse was elected by unanimous vote of the Council.

The reading of the Journal for the previous meeting was dispensed with on motion of Mr. Bach, seconded by Mr. Ransom.

#### COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE MAYOR

December 20, 1938.

To the Honorable President and Members of the Common Council of the City of Indianapolis, Indiana.

#### Gentlemen:

I have today approved with my signature and delivered to Daniel J. O'Neill, Jr., City Clerk, the following ordinances:

#### SPECIAL ORDINANCE No. 12, 1938

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the sale, alienation and conveyance of certain land of the City of Indianapolis, and fixing a time when the same shall take effect.

#### GENERAL ORDINANCE No. 93, 1938

AN ORDINANCE transferring the sum of Two Hundred Seventynine Dollars and fifty cents (\$279.50) from the 1938 Municipal Airport Budget Fund No. 51 to certain other funds of said budget, and fixing a time when the same shall take effect.

#### GENERAL ORDINANCE No. 99, 1938

AN ORDINANCE transferring the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) from a certain fund of the Department of Law to a certain other designated fund of said department, and fixing a time when the same shall take effect.

#### GENERAL ORDINANCE No. 101, 1938

AN ORDINANCE approving a certain contract heretofore entered into by the Board of Public Safety, acting for the City of Indianapolis, with Wayne Township of Marion County, Indiana, and fixing a time when this ordinance shall take effect.

#### GENERAL ORDINANCE No. 102, 1938

AN ORDINANCE approving a certain contract heretofore entered into by the Board of Public Safety, acting for the City of Indianapolis, with Washington Township of Marion County, Indiana, and fixing a time when the same shall take effect.

#### GENERAL ORDINANCE No. 103, 1938

AN ORDINANCE allocating the funds of the City of Indianapolis to be derived in the year 1939 from the tax levy and rate levied in the year 1938, in such a manner that the expenditures of said city for the year 1939 shall remain within the limitations

fixed in accordance with Sections 5 and 8 of Chapter 119 of the Acts of the Indiana General Assembly, 1937, and fixing a time when the same shall take effect.
