Also that an order issue to the committee on public wells for \$129:87 and that said committee pay said amount to said Shea in full of said contract if said security be given

(Issd 9 Decr. to Seibert)

Ordered That an order issue to the Committee on public wells for \$204:55 and that they pay the same to John Greer provided he receives the same in full of his account for brick - and take his receipt thereof -

(Issd. 9 Decr. 1840 to Seibert)
