

Council Chamber  
Indianapolis, April 13th 1844.

Council met: present Messrs. Griffith, Goldsberry, Louden, Montague, Nowland and Rooker.

Mr. Louden in the Chair.

Mr. Griffith from the Select committee appointed for that purpose reported "that they had examined the Pond-drain north east of town, that the same needed some repairs, and asked for an appropriation of five dollars for said purpose" which report was concurred in and said appropriation made.

The President laid before the Council the Treasurers monthly report which was read and received: also the Treasurers Annual report which was read and on Motion of Mr. Goldsberry the Secretary and the Treasurer were appointed a committee to examine and compare the same with the receipts and monthly reports of the Treasurer filed from time to time during the years 1843 and 4, with the view of receiving said report: and said committee to report thereon at the next meeting of the Council.

The President laid before the Council the Weighmasters monthly report which was read and received.

On Motion of Mr. Nowland

Ordered That the Marshal notify James P. Drake of a nuisance complained of in the alley immediately north of his Tavern. N. B. Palmer of a nuisance complained of in Illinois Street immediately west of his Tavern, E. Browning agent of J. R. Pratt of a nuisance complained of on the north east of the lot and premises occupied by T. J. Barnett, and E. S. Alvord of a nuisance complained of in the alley immediately south of his residence, and request them to have the same abated; and on their failing to do the same within a reasonable time, to himself proceed to abate said nuisances according to law, and inform the President of the town thereof.
