

Council Chamber
Indianapolis April 1st. 1845.

Council met, Present Messrs. Griffith, Montague and Nowland of the Council.

Joseph A. Levy Esq. presented his commission as President of the Common Council for the insuing year, and took his seat as such.

Mr. Samuel Goldsberry, Councilman elect for the Second Ward for the term of two years -- Mr. Andrew A. Loudon, Councilman elect for the fourth Ward, for the term of two years, and Mr. William C. Vanblaricum, Councilman elect, for the Sixth Ward, for the term of two years - Presented their certificates of Election, and after having severally taken an Oath of office, administered by the President took their seats in the Council.

The President laid before the Council, the Bond of Thomas Donnellan, Lister of the Town of Indianapolis, for its acceptance and approval, and thereupon it was accepted and approved.

The President laid before the Council the Bond of N. N. Norwood, Marshal of the Town of Indianapolis, for its acceptance and approval, And thereupon the same was accepted and approved.

The President laid before the Council, the Bond of James G. Jordan, Secretary of said Council, for its acceptance and approval, and thereupon the same was accepted and approved.

And the Council adjourned to meet at 3 o'clock on Saturday the 5th of April A. D. 1845.
