Council Chamber Indianapolis Janry 25th 1850

The Council met, Present Messrs King, Montague, Cully, Sulgrove and Mr President.

The business of the meeting being in refference to allowing Interest on the Orders issued to the Independent Relief Fire Company for the purchase of the Good Intent Engine by the Council from said Company.

On motion of Mr Cully the Secretary was ordered to insert in said Orders, the words with Interest, which motion was carried by Consent,

(485) Allowed, D. L. Farnam of Cincinnatti \$15.00 for Repairing, Hose of Marion Engine,

A communication was presented by Mr Eckert to the Council, from the Boys Bucket Company of this City, asking the Council to aid them in the purchase of a Wagon suitable to carry their Buckets on, said petition was refered to a committee, consisting of Messrs Montague, King, and Cully,

On motion of Mr Cully, The Street Commissioner is hereby ordered to make a Report to the Secretary, of all work heretofore done by him in his official capacity, with the amount annexed thereto for Individuals in this city, so that the amount for work done can be added to their Corporation taxes, said motion carried unanamously.
