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ABSTRACT

History of Indiana Moss Studies. WINONA H. WELCH, DePauw University.—There are records of moss collections in Indiana from 1875 to the present, including each of the counties in the state. At least 96 articles have been published concerning Indiana bryophytes, the most recent publication being a book of 478 pages by this author, entitled *Mosses of Indiana*, treating 25 families, 92 genera, and 260 species, varieties, and forms known to occur in the state. Among the least collected mosses of the state is *Grimmia trichophylla* var. *indianensis*, so named because the type specimen of this variety was collected in Indiana.
