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Cover photo: The Wabash River drains an area of 32,910 square miles, including about 8,704 square miles in Illinois and another 285 square miles in northwestern Ohio. It drains central and southern Indiana and flows in a southwesterly direction. Its upper watershed consists primarily of ground moraine and end moraines deposited during the Wisconsin glacialiation. The greatest elevation within the basin is 366 m and the lowest at the mouth is about 92 m above sea level.
