Manuscripts of 10-20 pages on any topic related to basic writing will be welcome as of January 1985, in the new MLA style in *MLA Handbook for Writers of Research Papers*, 1984 (also *MLA Handbook for Scholars*, coming 1985); and for the referee process, in quadruplicate with *identifying information on a cover page only*. Prospective authors can send a self-addressed, stamped envelope to request the new JBW "Editorial Statement" and the JBW "Style Sheet."
